Grand Van Gogh Exhibition Terrace of a Café at Night

Vincent van Gogh (1853-90) is one of the most prominent artists representing the Netherlands. Despite his global recognition as an artist who established a strong presence like no other as of today, he encountered various hardships throughout his life. However, he took the courage to confront these difficulties in life and found in his art the strength not to give up, healing, and comfort.

The entitled exhibition will present the finest artworks from the collection of the Kröller-Müller Museum, including the renowned *Terrace of a Café at Night*. In the first round of the two-time exhibition, which is to be convened in 2025, the year commemorating 30 years from the Great Hanshin/Awaji Earthquake, will trace Van Gogh's path to recognition, featuring works from his early years in the Netherlands through to his time in Arles.
