Grand Van Gogh Exhibition

The Langlois Bridge at Arles

Titled *The Langlois Bridge at Arles*, this new exhibition will also tour Japan, beginning in Kobe and traveling to Fukushima and Tokyo.

A highlight of this exhibition is *The Langlois Bridge at Arles* (1888), from the collection of the Kröller-Müller Museum. This masterpiece is regarded as a national treasure of the Netherlands and is rarely loaned abroad. Its presentation in Japan marks the first time in approximately 70 years. Created shortly after Van Gogh's move from Paris to Arles, the painting is known for its striking use of bright blue and yellow tones.

The second installment also sheds light on the final chapter of Van Gogh's life. It begins with the collapse of his cohabitation with fellow artist Paul Gauguin, the infamous "ear-cutting incident," and his departure from Arles.
